CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All entries must be registered or eligible for registration by WPCS and registration numbers must be shown on entry form. WPCS rules apply.

All incorrect entries will be returned

The Judges' decision is final. If only one entry forward the Judge may award whichever prize merited by that entry

It is at the Judges/Committees discretion as to whether a class is held up if an exhibitor is in another class

Foals must be at least 3 weeks old on the day of the show and accompany their dam in the ring

Colts 4 years and over must hold a stallion licence and number must be quoted on entry form

Riders of stallions must have reached their 12th birthday by the 1st January of the current year to ride Sec A,B, C or partbred 13.2hh and under, or their 14th birthday by the 1st January of the current year to ride Sec D or partbred over 13.2hh

A ridden animal shall be deemed to be a Novice if, by 1st January of the current year, it has not won an Open class within the discipline in which it is currently competing.

Exhibitors must not enter an animal bred by the Judge or in which the Judge has had financial involvement

Performance Medal offered to Champion in accordance with WPCS medal regulations

The WY WPCA will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury however caused

All exhibitors are advised to have their own 3rd party insurance

Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground and be to British current standards

It is the responsibility of each competitor to ensure they are in the ring for their class/classes

It is the Exhibitor/Owner's responsibility to ensure that the animal to be shown is entered in the correct class, as once the catalogue has been printed and forwarded to the WPCS the animal entered in the wrong class cannot transfer to another class

No refund of entry fee shall be made if an exhibitor misses a class

Objections are to be lodged within 30 minutes of the end of class, with £30 deposit, which will be returned if the objection is sustained

No mucking out of horseboxes on showground

All dogs must be kept on a lead and owners must clean up after their dogs

All attendees at our Show are reminded to conduct themselves in a courteous manner

Last of all – please remember to bring your passports for the animals you are showing
